Mdm Saleemah Ismail, CEO, shared an insight into New Life Stories who support the children of incarcerated parents in Singapore and work to break the cycle of incarceration through a holistic approach with the families of prisoners, including in-prison workshops to prepare incarcerated parents for their release and successful reintegratioon back into society.







The Young Leaders aim to raise at least \$5,000 over the course of the next year to support New Life Stories and to raise awareness of the organisation and got their fundraising efforts off to a great start with over \$1,900 raised from the event. ## Boys' Town - 'Project Mettle' in Ireland

After a Covid pandemic related delay of over three years, The Ireland Funds Singapore supported Adventure Leadership Programme at Boys' Town was finally able to get under way this year. Eight residential boys participated in the **Project Mettle expedition in Ireland** between 31 May 2023 to 15 June 2023. This is part of a transformative 12-month journey-based programme, funded by TIFS grant award, designed to enhance the confidence and resilience the Boy's Town boys through engagement in outdoor adventures.





In Phase 1 of Project Mettle, the boys were equipped with fundamental outdoor skills, immersing themselves in activities such as outdoor cooking and camping in Singapore. These experiences served as a stepping stone to prepare them for Phase 2 in Ireland.

In Ireland, the boys ventured into adventure-based learning at Killary Adventure Company in Galway where they did turf challenge, cliff-jumping, and kayaking. The subsequent week was dedicated to cultural immersion and in Dublin, allowing the Boy's Town boys to gain an understanding of the Irish community and culture through exchanges.





As part of the final Phase 3 of this transformative journey, the boys will take part in a service learning experience in Balai, Indonesia at the end of the year. The trip has left lasting impressions and insights on each boy, inspiring them to integrate these valuable teachings in their everyday lives.

"I had an amazing experience stepping out of my comfort zone by completing the activities at the campsite such as the cliff jump! The highlight of the expedition was when we visited a Non-Governmental Organisation (NGO) where we had an opportunity to interact with Irish youths and play football together".

TIFS volunteers engaged with the boys at Boys' Town in advance of their visit to Ireland, taking part in their outdoor pursuit training and holding a Q&A session to share some insights to Ireland – food, weather, culture, sports - and what to expect from their exciting trip. The Ireland Funds also arranged for the group to meet with City Wise Education and Belvedere Youth Club for activities and exchange with Irish youth during their trip.









We look forward to hearing more and for some of our Young Leaders to join on Phase 3 for their service trip to Batam later this year!

In the meantime, congratulations to Boys' Town on their 75<sup>th</sup> Anniversary! We were delighted to join the Family Fiesta event on 10 June 2023, with Guest of Honour, President Halimah Yacob.
